Sparks.....

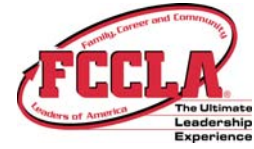
- \* give energy and joy

Participants cannot change their performance including their dress that was worn in tape or at the audition. Talent and appropriate dress will be considered when selecting the winners at The Ohio State Fair.

### **Date and Time of the Competition:**

The show will begin at 3:30 PM on Friday, July 29<sup>th</sup>. All participants must sign in at the Ohio FCCLA booth inside of the Youth Center by 3:00 PM on Friday, July 29<sup>th</sup>. Awards will follow the performances.



### **Spark Your Leadership Talent Show**

- Number of acts is limited to 20.
- The time limit is 4 minutes or less.
- Participants must supply own music
- Participants must complete Contract/Guidelines/Application
- Participants must supply source of music- CD player, etc.
  - A Portable Audio system will be provided
- Participants must be affiliated Ohio FCCLA members
- Participants must be grades 7-12 including recent graduates 2011

Participants will be provided with a fair pass, parking pass and one parent pass for the day of the competition. Participants are required to be in the Youth Center at least 1 hour prior to time of competition on the day of competition.

- The winner of the competition will receive a trophy and \$100 Savings Bond that will be shipped to them
- The top 3 performances will receive an Outstanding of the Day rosette.

If there is a Champions of Champions of Talent at the Ohio State Fair Youth Center, the winner would be eligible to compete.
